NISGA'A MUSEUM CONSTRUCTION FINANCING ACT

Financial Administration Act

1. This Act applies despite the *Nisga'a Financial Administration Act*.

Permitted borrowing

2. The Nisga'a Nation may obtain a loan of up to \$6,000,000 from a savings institution or Nisga'a settlement trust to enable the Nisga'a Nation
 - (a) to construct a public museum facility on land within the Nisga'a Village of Laxgalts'ap for the receipt, storage and display of cultural artifacts and related purposes, and
 - (b) before the museum facility referred to in paragraph (a) is opened to the public, to receive, store and display cultural artifacts in that facility, including Nisga'a artifacts referred to in the Cultural Artifacts and Heritage Chapter of the Nisga'a Treaty.

Security for loan

3. In order to obtain a loan under section 2, the Nisga'a Nation may grant, renew and replace security, including in respect of the land referred to in section 2 or an interest in that land.

Executive authority

4. The Executive may
 - (a) exercise the authorities of the Nisga'a Nation under sections 2 and 3, and
 - (b) do all things it considers necessary to give effect to sections 2 and 3.
